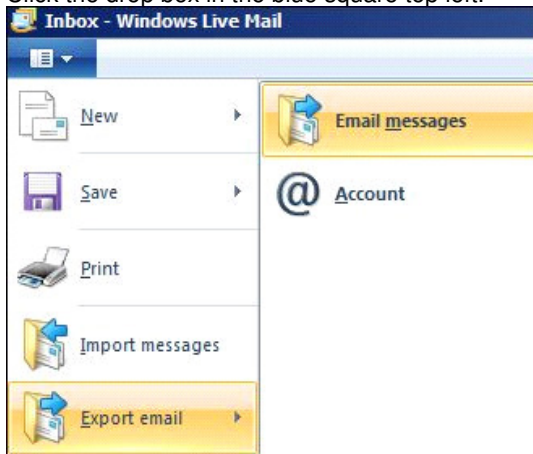


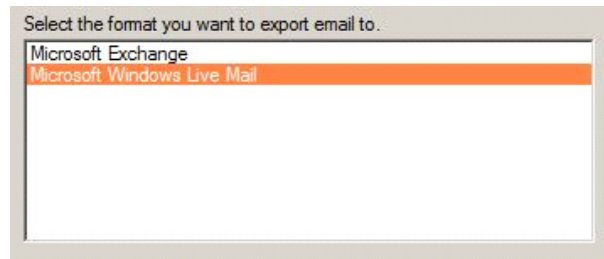
To Export messages in Windows Live Mail.

First, make a new folder on the Desktop, name it as the **Export** date i.e. **26 Sept 2013**

Click the drop box in the blue square top left.

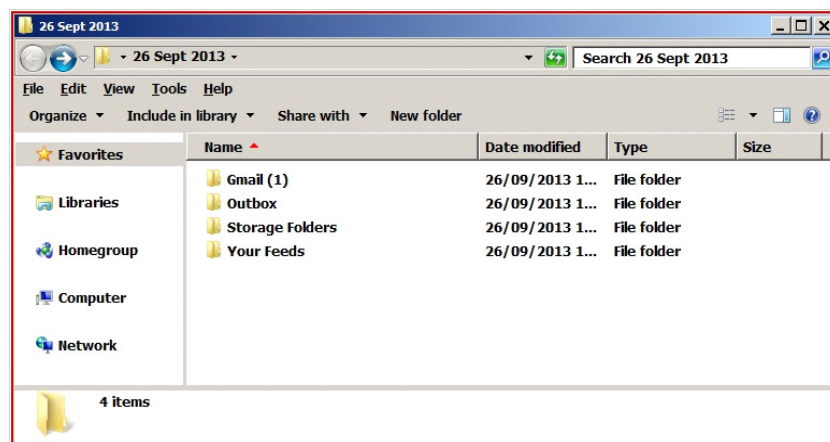


Select as above.

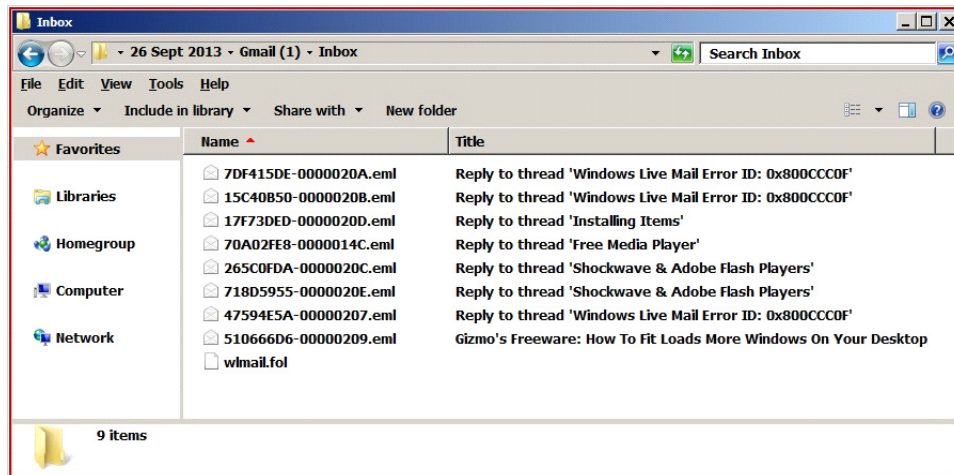


Select **Microsoft Windows Live Mail**, click Next.

Click **Browse** and select your new folder, click **Next**. Leave as **All folders**, click **Next** then Click **Finish**.



These are the main folders that were saved. Each one has sub folders.



The image above is my new folder **26 Sept 2013 > Gmail (1) > Inbox** folder.

Every sub folder has an entry called **wlmail.fol** which is for **Importing** into **WLM**. Any message can be opened and read by clicking it, without **Importing** into **WLM**. I never **Import** anything, I just delete any entry or folders I don't want.

Now move the **26 Sept 2013** folder to a folder called **Saved Mail** and put it anywhere you want. You can repeat it anytime by making a folder using the date as the name of your next **Export**.
